Springboro was incorporated as a village in 1815 and as a city in 1987.

Springboro covers a land area of 10 square miles and has 88 miles of streets.

Parks - The **City of Springboro** operates and maintains 6 recreational parks:

North Park - 195 Tamarack Trail - 39 acres

North Park is located on Tamarack Trail and has 2 lighted tennis courts, 3 soccer fields, 1 shelter, 1 playground area, a concession stand, .89 mile walking trail and offers a summer concert series in July and theatre under the stars in August at the North Park Amphitheater.

Community Park - 666 West Market Street - 18 acres

Located on Market Street, Community Park has 2 lighted tennis courts, 1 basketball court, 2 baseball fields, 2 playground areas, 2

shelter houses, 1 concession stand and 2 equipment buildings.

Clearcreek Park - 500 Lower Springboro Road - 137.5 acres

Located on Lower Springboro Road, Clearcreek Park offers 10 soccer fields, 8 baseball/softball diamonds, 2 football/soccer/LAX fields, 1 shelter, 2 playgrounds and a concession stand.

E. Milo Beck - Lower Springboro Road - 85 acres

Located on Lower Springboro Road at the terminus of Pioneer Blvd., E. Milo Beck is a passive park with an overlook area and walking trails.

Gardner Park - Village Park Boulevard -16 acres

Located on Village Park Blvd., behind the Village Park Development on North Main Street, Gardner Park offers a paved walking trail and pond.

Rotary Park - South Main Street

Located in the 300 block of South Main Street in the Historic District, Rotary Park offers nice landscaping, a gazebo and benches for sitting and enjoying the quaint downtown. Rotary Park was made possible through a collaboration between the City and the Rotary Club of Springboro.

SPARC and Go - South Main Street

Rotary Park also contains the City's newest concept - A SPARC and Go. SPARC stands for Springboro Area Recharging Center. Built as part of the City's Bike and Pedestrian Plan, the SPARC and Go acts as a rest station for bicyclists as well as a recharging center during power outages or natural disasters.

Our park shelters are available for reservation by the day at no charge on a first-come, first-serve basis. Complete a park shelter reservation form and turn it in at the City building or fax it to 748-0815. A copy will be returned to you to confirm the reservation.

Trash-

Trash pickup day for City of Springboro residents is every **TUESDAY**. Take everything down to the curb on Monday night to ensure timely pick up. Separate trucks pick up trash, recycling, yard waste and bulk items.

TRASH CONTAINERS. Residents can use their own trash-cans and trash bags. If they choose, they can rent a toter from Waste Management by calling 800-343-6047. The rental is \$18.00 for six months.

RECYCLING. Recycling is picked up **every other Tuesday**; consult the map/calendar on the City website for pickup dates. If your home does not have a recycling bin, the City will deliver one to you at no charge. You have a choice of an 18 gal yellow bin or a 35, 64 or 96 gal toter. Call (937) 748-9721 to discuss your options and have a bin delivered to you.

YARD WASTE. Leaves and grass clippings must be placed in special environmentally friendly composting bags, which are available at any local hardware store. There can be no more than 10 bags per pick up. Garden waste must be tied in bundles no larger than 2 feet in diameter and 4 feet in length and weighing no more than 50 pounds. If you choose, you can rent a yard waste toter from Waste Management for \$3.00 per month, by calling them at 1-800-343-6047. You may also use your own trash can, provided it is clearly marked as a yard waste container

Any large **BULK ITEMS**, such as washers and dryers, may be placed at the curb on any given trash day, advanced notice to Waste Management is appreciated to ensure pick up. Any items containing Freon (i.e. refrigerators, A/C units, etc.) must have an appointment with Waste Management to remove the Freon for \$50 per item by calling them before the pick up at 1-800-343-6047.

No Construction materials, such as drywall, ceramic tile or concrete can be picked up. Carpet can be picked up provided that

it is cut into smaller pieces, rolled and bound in bundles. Paint cans may be picked up after the paint is hardened and lids are left off. A paint hardener can be purchased at local hardware stores.

Waste Management observes six **Holidays** throughout the year. **Only if the holiday falls on Monday or Tuesday, does Waste Management pick up your trash on Wednesday.** These holidays are: Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day.

Utilities (water, sewer & trash) -

Springboro Utility Department handles water, sewer and trash billing. Bills are generated the 1st of each month and due the 20th of each month.

From mid June through mid September a sewer reduction program is offered to all residents for grass watering.
