Bicycle Friendly Business Days reward cyclists for getting out of their motor vehicles and giving cycling a try while supporting participating businesses.

- Free access to bicycle information including the City's Biking in the Boro Pocket Guide.
- Free access to public restrooms.
- Free access to shelter from inclement weather.

The City of Springboro's Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee is partnering with Crooked Handle Brewing Company for Bike the Handle on Thursday, October 13, 2016. Biking the Handle starts at 6:15 p.m. at 760 North Main Street in the Marketplace at Settlers Walk Shopping Center in Springboro with a pre-ride orientation and a short 5-6 mile early fall bike ride on the streets of Springboro then returns to the brewery for a tour and \$1.00 off all pints for riders. All ride participants will be entered into a drawing for a Crooked Handle growler and glassware package.

This ride will take place on City streets at a moderate pace. Participants are responsible for making their own evaluation of traffic, roads and safety. All participants need to be 18 years of age or older or accompanied by an adult. All riders will need to have a helmet, front and rear bike lights and reflective clothing.
